

Civil War Keynote

Use the Civil War Topics list on history.com to complete your project. If there is a topic you want to do that is not listed, let me know. The keynote will focus on the 4 elements below:

1. One battle
2. One Person
3. One event or thing that is not a battle
4. One topic of your choice, it may be a battle, person, etc.

For each topic, you should include the following:

-4 slides (the first slide of each section will be a title slide)

-The remaining 3 slides should be a summary about the topic. Each slide should have 3-4 facts.

-Appropriate pictures on each slide. The pictures would help tell a story, don't just put a bunch of picture of the topic.
